Professor (<u>Dr.</u>) Ramesh <u>C.</u> Gaur is presently Dean, Director (Lib. & Inf.) & Head-Kalanidhi Division in **HAG scale Pay scale Level 15** at Indira Gandhi National Centre for the Arts (IGNCA), New Delhi, Ministry of Culture, Government of India. IGNCA www.ignca.gov.in. Prof. Gaur is one of the senior most faculty/official in IGNCA and also officiates for Member Secretary whenever he is on tour or /and on leave. As a Dean, IGNCA he is responsible for management and smooth running of various academic programmes including 7 PG Diploma Courses and 5 short term Certificate courses in various disciplines such as Cultural Management, South Asian Studies, Buddhism, Digital Library & Data Management, Cultural Informatics, Conservation, Folklore, Tribal studies, Research Methodology, Ethnographic Documentary making and Screen Writing etc.
