Cathakar-International Storytellers Festival aims to generate awareness on the traditional methods of storytelling in different parts of the world. Traditionally, folk tales, epics and community history were communicated orally with gestures and expressions to leave a lasting imprint on listener's mind. It was also a method to inculcate moral well being in humans. Earlier, the storyteller would sit under a tree and entertain the audience with his legendary tales.

IGNCA and Nivesh bring together a festival on the art of storytelling. Kathakar-International Storytellers Festival will be held from 11 to 13 November, 2016 at the Central Lawns, 11, Mansingh Road. This is the sixth edition of the festival. The performers this year are:

#### **National Storytellers**

**Tholpavakoothu Sangam** from Kerala. It is an international troupe of eight members headed by Shri K. Viswanatha Pulavar registered and working since 1992. From 1979 onwards, the group has had several international shows.

Danish Husain from Mumbai. He is a is a poet, actor, filmmaker, theatre director, one of the people who helped revive the lost art form of Urdu storytelling, 'Dastangoi'. He won the META for Best Supporting Actor in 2008, and Ustad Bismillah Khan Yuva Puruskar from Sangeet Natak Akademi in 2010.

Jaishree Sethi from New Delhi. She is a contemporary storyteller from New Delhi who runs an NGO called Story Ghar. With sixteen years of experience in Theatre, Radio and Television, she has mastered the craft of storytelling.

#### International story tellers:

Sarah Rundle from United Kingdom. A storyteller and actor based in West London. Trained in community storytelling in south Cheshire and in acting at Drama Studio, London, she has more than ten years of performing experience at various venues.

Spice Arthur 702 from Japan. It is an advance guard KAMISHIBAI group. Kamishibai is an original Japanese entertainment, in which the art of storytelling involves using pictures. The tradition has a long history in Japan

Giles Abbott from United Kingdom. He started storytelling in 1999 after sudden and severe, but no total, loss of sight in 1999. "I lost my sight and found my path", he says. Mr. Abbott has gone on to become one of the UK's leading storytellers performing all over the UK and internationally.

**Katy Cawkwell** from United Kingdom. She is a well-known storyteller from United Kingdom popular for her vivid and powerful storytelling performances. Ms. Cawkwell has been working for twenty years in schools, festivals, museums and theatres across Britain and beyond.
