

Advertisement for Recruitment of Junior Research Fellows for the Janapada Sampada Division, Indira Gandhi National Centre for the Arts (IGNCA)

IGNCA invites applications for Junior Research Fellows to assist in the following ongoing projects of the Centre.

1. Masks, Puppets and Picture Showmen Traditions in India
2. Folk Theatre: Traditions and Transformations
3. Folk and Tribal Traditions in Mahabharatha and Ramkatha
4. New Ritual Spheres and Changing Urbanscapes

Essential Qualification:

- a. Candidates who have secured at least 55% marks in master's degree or equivalent examination from a university/institution recognized by the UGC in any of the following subjects of Cultural Anthropology, Sociology, Performance Studies, Folklore, Art History/Museology/Cultural History or any related disciplines in Social Sciences and Humanities
- b. Candidates who have experience of working on the projects of the Social Sciences covering the areas of culture, history, folk art, oral tradition and ethnography.

Desirable Qualification:

- a. Candidates who have experience of preparing catalogues, editing of photographs, etc.
- b. Candidates who have experience of computer handling in the field of Microsoft Office and Picasa, internet surfing, Photoshop.

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Duration of Engagement: Engagement would be for a period of six months, extendable up to maximum of two years depending upon requirement.

Age Limit: The age should not be more than 35 years as for Junior Research Fellows as on 01-07-2010.

Amount of Fellowship.: The Fellowship amount will be Rs.15, 000/- p.m. for Junior Research Fellows

Leave: Leave of 30 days is admissible in one year as per rules of IGNCA

Termination of Fellowship : Fellowship may be terminated prematurely in the following circumstances:

- i. Consistent non submission of work report without any viable reason
- ii. Unsatisfactory performance even after proper guidance
- iii. Any misconduct, misbehavior which is unbecoming of a Fellow
- iv. Non observance of the Conduct Rules and other rules and regulations of IGNCA as applicable to its employees from time to time.
- v. Member Secretary, IGNCA Trust would be competent to terminate the fellowship on recommendation of the HOD (JS).

Submission of Progress Report: Junior Research Fellows will submit periodic progress report to the HOD (JS) through concerned coordinators of the respective projects of the Division. Continuance of the fellowship would be considered after a comprehensive review of the work done by the fellow.

Place of Posting: The Fellows will be posted in the IGNCA, New Delhi. The JRFs may be sent to any part of India for projects; for this, they would get TA/DA as per rules of IGNCA
